Bon Voyage Tag Designed by Karina Hittle of Artful Offerings™

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Materials

- 1 Sheet ~ 8-1/2" x 11" of printable fabric
- 1 ~ Size 4" x 7" rectangle of cotton batting
- 3 ~ Size 4" x 7" rectangles of iron-on interfacing
- 1 ~ Size 3/4" button to match or contrast the fabric
- 1 ~ Size 16" length of ribbon

All purpose sewing thread to match fabric

Directions

Note: Use manufacturer's directions when working with printable fabric.

- 1. Download the PDF of label front and back.
- 2. Use an ink-jet printer, print the label onto the printable fabric and let dry for 30 minutes. Carefully remove the paper backing from the printable fabric and press.
- 3. Use a see-thru ruler and rotary cutter to remove excess fabric, cutting just inside the black solid line {see diagram A} around each design for tag front and back. Tag front and back should be the same size.
- 4. Trim the cotton and iron-on interfacing to the exact size of the tag.
- 5. Stack an iron-on interfacing rectangle on top of batting, matching all edges and fuse. Fuse the second and third interfacing rectangles onto the first.
- 6. Lightly spray Sulky® KK2000™temporary spray baste onto the batting then stack and finger-press the tag front right-side up on the batting so it is flat, matching all edges.
- 7. Flip the tag over to expose the interfacing and lightly spray it with KK2000, then stack and finger-press the tag back right-side up on the interfacing so it is flat, matching all edges.
- 8. Small zigzag stitch {size 5.5 width x 1.0 length}, thru all layers, around the perimeter of the tag.
- 9. Sew the button to the top right-side corner of the tag {see diagram B}. Secure the ribbon around the button and attach the tag to the travel bag handle. If desired tack the tag in place with needle and thread.





Tag Back

Remove excess fabric just inside the black solid line.

Zigzag around the perimeter of the tag. Sew a button to the top right-side corner of the tag.
