On Page 1

Cutting Guide For Accessory Bag

From Large Floral, Cut:

2 {6" H x 13-1/2" W} Front & Back

Cutting Guide For Needle Booklet

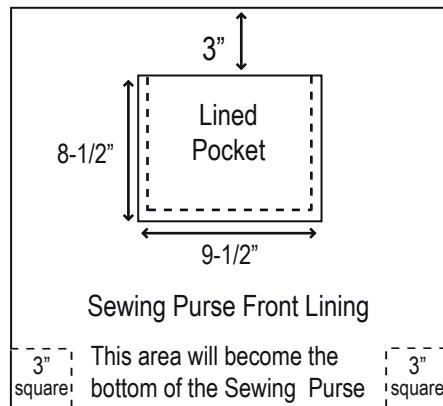
From Black Wool Felt, Cut:

2 {6" H x 3" W} Booklet Pages

On Page 2

Lining Preparation...See Diagram B

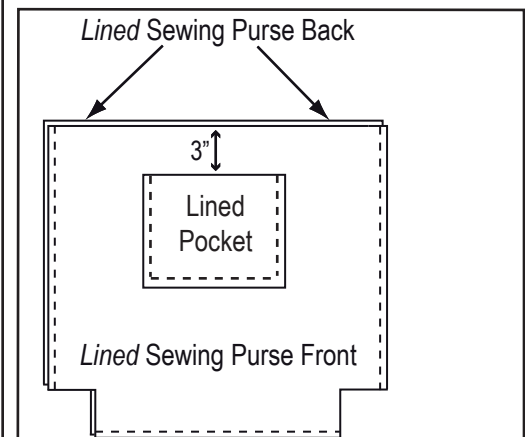
- To make a Lined Pocket, fold rectangle for Pocket, in half, matching edges to make a 10" W x 9" H rectangle.
- Center & pin Pocket to **right side** of Lining Front, 3" down from top edge. Put Tear Easy under work before sewing pocket in place. Remove Tear Easy.
- Apply Lite Steam-A-Seam to **backside** of Lining Front. Remove paper backing & fuse Lining Front to **backside** of quilted sandwich for Sewing Purse Front. Trim Lining to size. Repeat this Step for Lining Back.



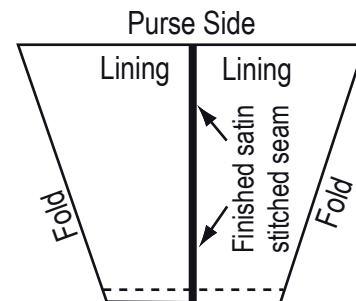
Apply Lite Steam-A-Seam to the **backside** of Lining Front **before** removing the 3" squares from the bottom of the Lining. 3" squares are removed when Lining is trimmed to size after fusing. **Repeat this for the Sewing Purse Back Lining.**

Diagram B: Lining Preparation

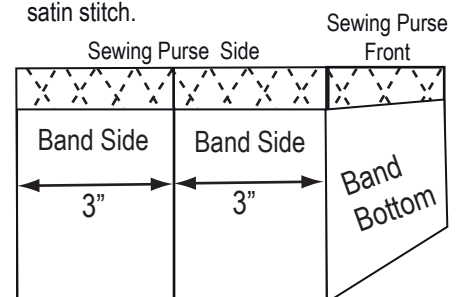

Straight stitch side and bottom edges together. Then finish seams with a satin stitch.



To form a boxed corner, bring the side and bottom edges together, matching the seam lines. Pin then sew a seam. Finish seam with a satin stitch.



Finished formed box corner after Sewing Purse has been turned right side out.

Diagram C: Forming Bottom Of Sewing Purse

Add this to Page 3 between "Forming The Bottom Of The Sewing Purse & Adding Binding, Button, Button Loop & Handles"

Making The Handle Loops And Button Loop

- With **right sides together**, fold a strip for a Handle Loop in half lengthwise & press. Pin then sew a 1/4" seam. You now have a tube. Turn tube **right side out** & roll seam to the center of the tube & press flat. Repeat this step for remaining Handle strips & the strip for the Button Loop. Set Handle tubes aside. *Note the seam side of the tube is the backside.*
- To form the Button Loop, align the cut ends of the tube side by side & fold the end of the tube into a flattened triangle. See Diagram E. The cut ends of the tube should be even & side by side. The sides of the tube should be the exact same length. Press & straight stitch across the flattened triangle. Set aside.

Forming The Bottom Of The Sewing Purse...See Diagram C

- With **wrong sides together**, pin side and bottom edges of the Lined Purse Front to Lined Purse Back, matching all edges.
